

MOSQUITO CONTROL

Preventing

Repelling

Gutter Guards

Foam insert leaf guards prevent mosquitoes from breeding.



Citronella Candles

These are handy for patios and decks, and can keep mosquitoes away.



Pond Dunks

Use these in garden ponds to keep them from becoming breeding spots.



Clothing Sprays

Treat clothing with permethrin products to repel mosquitoes.

Repellents

Use only EPA-registered repellents for best results in repelling mosquitoes.



Septic System

Leaks or penetrations into the septic system can provide places for mosquitoes to breed.



Sprays

Use these chemical sprays on lawns, shrubs, decks and patios to kill mosquitoes.

Screens

Keep all insects out of the house by repairing holes in screens.



Traps

These attract mosquitoes and trap them. They can cover an entire yard.



Flower Pots

Clear standing water from places such as garbage cans, pet water dishes, flower pots, birdbaths, toys and old tires. These can be a breeding ground for mosquitoes.



Fan

A fan on the deck or porch creates an air stream that makes it difficult for mosquitoes to fly, a great, low-cost way of repelling the insects.
